### Project Information

**Project Name:** Equipment for Girl's Quidditch Rec League

#### **Description of Project:**

There are very few opportunities at Hogwarts for girls to engage in physical activity. The official house quidditch teams have limited spots, which means that only a small proportion of Hogwarts students have an opportunity to play and it's difficult to get one of those spots without previous training and experience. Furthermore, a disproportionate number of quidditch players are male, which makes joining a house team very intimidating for girls. This has serious implications for the physical health and confidence of the witches of Hogwarts.

The Girl's Quidditch Rec League seeks to fill this gap by offering a fun, safe and welcoming atmosphere for girls to practice their flying skills and learn the game of quidditch. The club will provide an outlet for witches who want to bond with their fellow students and get a workout in. It will also give those who want an opportunity to hone their skills with the eventual goal of trying out for a house team.

The club will meet once a week. We have been approved to use the quidditch pitch Monday afternoons and flying instruction will be provided by Madam Hooch and Ginny Weasley (who plays for the Gryffindor team.)

**Requested Amount:** \$4,890

#### **Preliminary Budget:**

Funds awarded by the WAA Trust will be used for start-up costs for the club. Many witches do not have their own equipment or brooms and we want the club to be as accessible to as many students as possible. Ideally we would like to order enough equipment for 2 teams of 7 players each so we could scrimmage. We have asked anyone who already has their own quidditch equipment to bring it so that we can provide equipment to as many people as possible.

There will be a small cost to join the club and these funds will be used for repairs and to purchase new equipment on an annual basis. Receiving funding from the WAA Trust will help our club become self-sufficient and take the financial burden of purchasing equipment or paying high dues off our members.

14 Cleansweep flying brooms – 14 x \$200 = \$2,800

14 sets of quidditch robes – 14 x \$80 = \$1,120

14 sets of quidditch gloves – 14 x \$40 = \$560

4 beater's bats – 4 x 50 = \$200

1 set of balls (one quaffle, two bludgers, one golden snitch) – 1 x \$180

First aid kit - \$30
